Marsha R. Smith, MD, MPH, is the Medical Director, Perinatal Health for the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene's Center for Maternal and Child Health. Dr. Smith joined the Department in February 2007 and serves as medical consultant for the Department's Fetal and Infant Mortality Review (FIMR), Child Fatality Review and Maternal Mortality Review Programs. Dr. Smith is also the medical consultant for the Maryland Child Abuse and Neglect Medical Providers Initiative which is administered in collaboration with the University of Maryland School of Medicine. In current her role, Dr. Smith participates in the review process for perinatal referral center designation. She participates as a member of the hospital site review team which is conducted in collaboration with the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems (MIEMSS). Prior to joining the Department, Dr. Smith was the Medical Director, for the Baltimore City Health Department's Sexually Transmitted Diseases Clinic at the Druid Health Center, where she was also a faculty member for the Region III STD/HIV Prevention and Training Center (a program of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Baltimore City Health Department and the Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions). While with the Baltimore City Health Department Dr. Smith was an associate staff pediatrician with the Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions in the Department of Pediatrics and a clinical Associate with the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. Dr. Smith received her Doctor of Medicine Degree from the University of Pittsburgh, and her Masters of Public Health Degree from the Johns Hopkins University Bloomberg School of Public Health. Doctor Smith, is a board certified pediatrician and is a fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics.
